PRAYER FOR THE CHURCH

For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it? I will make a pathway through the wilderness. I will create rivers in the dry wasteland. Isaiah 43: 19

The Church has begun to grow afresh, resulting in the need for more chairs.

- Thank God for the fresh growth.
- Thank God for the spirit of reconciliation, as some members who had left because they felt the missionaries were interfering with cultural matters (with the issue of Bose, who was sold into slavery and our efforts to rescue her and rehabilitate her) and other matters have returned to the church.

- Thank God for the positive effect the issue of Bose's transformation, is having amongst the Beninese people who were formerly angry with us.
- Ask God to continue to help us impact the culture positively and for the church to grow.
- Ask God to make pathways for us as a church into the surrounding villages.
- Pray that the church would receive a fresh inflow of men and women, old and young in all villages to hear His word.
- Use Acts 13:44 to pray for church growth for us. **"On the next sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord."**
- Ask God to continue to help the entire congregation experience the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.
- Use Romans 15: 29 to pray for the fullness we long for as a church:

But I know that when I come to you, I shall come in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.

- Pray for the Spirit of understanding and commitment to the church to grow further and further in Jesus' name.
- Pray against every attempt of Satan to limit the growth of the church spiritually and numerically.
- Ask God to do marvellous deeds through our work in Oyegunle and the surrounding villages.
- Ask God to give us all the villages under Oyegunle mission field: Onidundun, Eleyele, Bamako etc.

- Ask God to give us souls of all the baale's, men and women, souls of the youth and the teenagers around us.

PRAYERS OF THANKSGIVING

- Let's give thanks to God over SOL Trustees and Partners.

Ps.34.1, 3 - I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth. O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.

- Let's thank God for the heart of generosity He has given to SOL Trustees and Partners.
- Thank God for helping them to live lives of generosity.

"I will [not merely walk, but] run the way of Your commandments, when You give me a heart that is willing (an enlarged heart)."

In light of our new realities as a ministry - Nigeria/Benin mission work (and in a few years other nations), SOL needs to rejig her partnership structure, build new partnership bases and start new media that will take our work to the next level.

- Pray for wisdom and strategy for constructive restructuring.

Prov.2.6 - For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

- Ask for wisdom and favour to build new partnership bases (partnership cells in different places and across nations and continents).

THE WEBSITE AND NEXT LEVEL

The website is up and running, the board of trustees has made their input and the website is now functioning.

- Thank God for the success of the project.
- Ask that the spirit of favour will rest on the website.
- Pray for great receptivity from the Christian public and captains of industry and leaders in the body of Christ as well.

- Pray for skillful management of the website, ensuring all security features are fully in place.
- Use Exodus 31:3 to pray our father, Pastor Henry, Bro Isaac and the team around them:
- Ask God to fill them with the spirit of wisdom, abilities, intelligence, knowledge and craftsmanship.
- Besides the website, pray that the Lord will open our eyes and give us skills on how to maximize the various opportunities and media platforms to push missions and evangelism forward.
- Pray for God to raise a team of creative genius for SOL that will use Instagram, TikTok, Twitter, and YouTube differently from what SOL is already doing with Facebook.

MISSIONS, SOL AND THE NEXT GENERATION

SOL is working on an online TV of short films, pacy documentaries and short missional messages targeted at reaching the Millennial Generation (circa 1981 to 1996) and Gen Z (post-Millennial) (circa 1997 to 2012) generations. The online TV will be called Missions Tv.

- Work is already going on two scripts. Pray for the spirit of inspiration and creative ingenuity on Pastor Wole and Pastor David.
- Pray for resources for cameras, lightening, and other types of equipment.
- Pray for more wisdom and strategy on how to use the Missions Tv to impact the Millennial generation and Gen Z.

- Pray that the Missions Tv will be a tool in the hand of the Lord for many to find their purpose in the Great Commission.

God has used and continues to use the baby boomers generation and Generation X to go for missions and to support missions.

- Pray that as their age so will their strength be.
- Pray for a fresh dose of supernatural strength, supernatural provision and preservation for those in these generation brackets.
- Use Psalm 89:17 to pray for them: **For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.**
